1 **Policy Statement**

2 The student of any parent/guardian who falsifies any information required by this district, shall not be
3 permitted to enroll nor to continue enrollment in the Crockett County School District. Failure to submit
4 an application for non-resident students may result in immediate dismissal from the Crockett County
5 School District.

6 RESIDENCY IS DETERMINED BY ADDRESS OF LEGAL PRIMARY CUSTODIAN.

7 **Application Procedure**

8 Students residing outside the boundaries of Crockett County may apply for enrollment within the
9 school system under the following conditions:¹

- 10 1. New Non-resident students must make application prior to July 14th.²
- 11
- 12 2. New students must provide the building principal with current documentation regarding grades,
13 discipline, attendance and any special needs BEFORE a decision on admission can be made.
14 Failure to furnish this documentation will result in a denial of enrollment.

- 16 3. Non-resident student transfers from other school systems within Crockett County will be
17 treated the same as students residing outside the boundaries of Crockett County.
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- 19 4. Provided space is available, non-resident students will be enrolled at a specific school only for
20 the current school year. Non-resident students must re-apply each year prior to May 1st.
21 Enrollment will be granted (provided all conditions are met successfully) as space is available
22 in the next grade level at that school or in the next grade level at the school of normal grade
23 progression within Crockett County.

- 25 5. There is no guarantee of enrollment for succeeding years. Discipline, attendance, tardiness, or
26 academic issues may result in a student being denied reenrollment as a non-resident student.²

- 28 6. All non-resident students must be approved by the director of schools on the recommendation
29 of the building principal.
- 30
- 31 7. New Non-resident applicants will be notified of enrollment status before July 15th of the current
32 school year. Returning non-resident students will be notified of their enrollment status by June
33 10th of the current school year.

- 1 8. Enrollment is closed for non-resident students when 90% of EIA maximums are reached in
2 respective classes. Approved criteria (ranked top to bottom) to be considered in determining
3 enrollment priority of non-resident students (when necessary) includes:
 - 4 a. Children or grandchildren of district employee;
 - 5 b. Academic/attendance records;
 - 6 c. Discipline record of applicant;
 - 7 d. Student previously enrolled (longevity);
 - 8 e. Siblings enrolled;
 - 9 f. Family pays county taxes;
 - 10 g. Waiting list (admission request date).
- 11 9. All out of district acceptance decisions are tentative due to potential changes in in-district
12 enrollment.
- 13 10. Non-resident students found by the Disciplinary Hearing Authority or Truancy Board to be in
14 violation of Crockett County Schools' discipline policies or attendance policies may not be
15 permitted to continue enrollment in the Crockett County school district.
- 16 11. Applicants and non-resident students that have failed two or more courses in the previous
17 semester may not be accepted or permitted to continue enrollment the following year in the
18 Crockett County school district.
- 19 12. There shall be no obligation for the Crockett County School District to provide transportation
20 for non-resident pupils.
